Prospective Seal Beach Lion-

Who are we? We are the Seal Beach Lions Club numbering over 300 members (the largest club in California and the 2nd largest in the USA). Our club was founded in 1939 and has been a dedicated local service organization for more than 75 years. Our mission is to help the less fortunate and improve our community. We also serve the communities of Rossmoor and Los Alamitos.

How do I become a Seal Beach Lion? Membership is by invitation only. A current member must sponsor you into the club. To be eligible to join, you need to attend two club meetings, events or projects (one must be a meeting). Once you have met this minimum requirement, your sponsor can bring you to a club Board of Directors meeting and present you for membership. (Note: Board meetings immediately follow general meetings at the second meeting of the month)

Dues – There is a one-time \$25 initiation fee. Annual dues are \$100 per year and are prorated through June 30th. The initial amount varies based on when you join. Ask you sponsor or the club Treasurer for the exact amount. Dues are collected when you join and then annually in May. (Special Membership categories: Initiation fees for family members are waived and there are reduced dues for the second member. There is also a special dues rate for former Leos and full-time students)

Expectations - We have no attendance requirements but encourage members to attend meeting when they can (1st and 3rd Wednesday – 7pm). You can join in on projects, fundraisers and social events at any time – Serve when you can.

You pay dues at the time you are voted in. As an alternative, they can be mailed in to:

You will officially become a Lion when the application and dues are received and the board has voted you in.

If you have any questions, ask you sponsor, an officer or one of the membership team members.
