Eisenhower Park by the Seal Beach Pier – 900 Ocean Avenue

Show Hours: Saturday 9am – 5pm <> Sunday 9am – 4pm

The Seal Beach Lions Foundation is proud to present the 48th annual Seal Beach Arts & Crafts Faire. This year's show will have nearly 100 vendors, food, a youth art area, music and more.

Salable Items:

This is a juried show, returning vendors will not need to submit photos unless they are adding to their previously approved product line. New vendors will need to submit an application and photos of their work before they are accepted. The application can be found at sealbeachlions.org. Directions for the submission of the application can be found on the application.

To ensure a quality and balanced faire, our emphasis is on hand-crafted items created by the vendor. A limited number of commercial products can be sold so long as the balance of the items is 80/20, with 80% being handcrafted by the vendor.

We have a limited number of food vendor booths available. Important: All vendors selling food items (including candy, cookies, jams, and breads) must obtain an Orange County Environmental Health Permit. Information can be obtained at www.ocfoodinfo.com.

Please note that compliance of each booth will be verified at the start of the show, booths that do not meet requirements will be removed for non-compliance and no refunds will be offered.

Booths

Locations: All spaces have been pre-assigned. Please refer to the space location guide for each numbered location. There will be no changes to locations as all spaces are committed.

Regular booth locations will fit a 10x10 canopy. In most cases, there is a minimum 2' gap between the booths. Please be sure that you stay within the chalk lines marked for your booth. Booth numbers or letters will be marked with chalk on the walkway in front of your booth. Please do not encroach on the walkways. Booth depth vary but are a minimum of 10'. You are welcome to go deeper as long as it does not interfere with other Artisans.

Vendors must supply their own canopy, booth, tables, chairs and weights. Canopies and Umbrellas must be secured using weights – winds are unpredictable in this location.

Small Booths Locations: We have a few smaller locations where canopies will need to extend into the ground cover. Canopies must stay off the walkway and all tables and materials must stay on the grass.

Subletting: Vendors are not allowed to share or sublet their booths without prior approval.

Staffing: Artisan booths must remain up and operating during the entire show: Saturday from 9am to 5pm and Sunday from 9am to 4pm. Artisans who do not adhere to the full show hours may not be invited back.

Portable PA Systems: You may not use a portable PA system in your booth.

SATURDAY Set-Up: Vendors may set up as early as 5 am on the Saturday morning. Unloading/Loading will

be on Ocean Blvd. You will not be able to unload directly in front of your spot, please bring a cart to help you unload your merchandise. You may remain in the loading zone for no more than 20 minutes. Anyone exceeding the Unloading/Loading time of 20 minutes is subject to being towed.

All booths MUST be ready for presentation by 8:30am. The show begins at 9am.

SUNDAY Set-Up: You may arrive as early as 6:30am to restock your booth. Use the same unloading area and please move your vehicle once unloaded. The show on Sunday also starts at 9am.

SUNDAY Break-Down: The show remains open on Sunday until 4pm. Please start the breakdown process no earlier than 4pm. Vendors MUST fully break down their booths before moving vehicles to the Ocean Avenue staging area. Please note that the staging area cannot accommodate all vendors at one time. Vehicles may only be parked on Ocean Avenue for loading after 4:15 pm and only during the actual loading process. You may remain in the loading zone for no more than 20 minutes. Anyone exceeding the Unloading/Loading time of 20 minutes is subject to being towed. If you are asked to move your car, please do so as we are trying to make the process smooth for all vendors.

Please put all trash in waste receptacles and leave your booth space the way you found it.

City Business License: All vendors are required to have a City of Seal Beach business license. The cost is included in the registration fee and the Lions have acquired your license from the city. No action is required of you.

Security: Security personnel will be present throughout the entire show and will be wearing Security vests. We will also have overnight security from 5pm – 8am. Booths and tables may remain overnight; however, we are not responsible for any equipment or merchandise.

Parking: Vendors are responsible for their own parking. Parking in the 10th or 8th Street parking lots is recommended. There is no parking on Ocean Avenue in front of the event. The parking lots use the Passport Parking App, it is recommended that you download the app prior to arrival.

Restrooms: We have supplied restrooms on each side of the park for Artisan use. There are also public restrooms located under the pier.

Other:

- The Lions Information Booth near the pier entrance will be manned from 5am-5:30pm on Saturday and 7am – 4pm on Sunday.
- In the pier entrance area, there will be food, non-profit booths and some youth art activities.
- The Food booth is open from 10:30am-3pm on Saturday and Sunday. Deliveries to Artisan Booths is from 11am – 3pm. Food order forms will be dropped off at each booth.
- The show will go on regardless of the weather. There are no refunds for cancellations after June 30, 2026. There is a \$30 service charge for cancellations.
